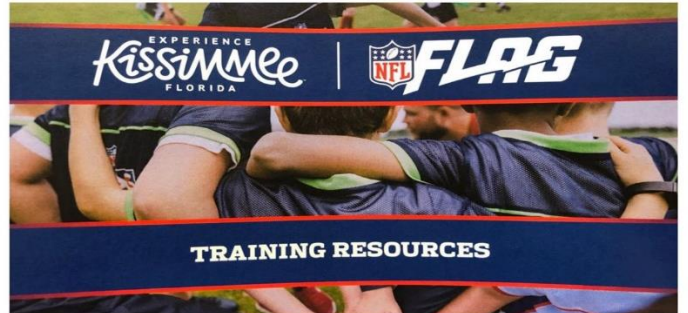
Panathlon KS1
