Schools FAQ

○ What is the purpose of this challenge?

To motivate your staff and pupils to be physically active on their return to school. We all know the benefits of leading an active lifestyle on our physical and mental health, which is more prevalent now more than ever.

○ Why visit Barnet's schools?

As we start to recover from the pandemic it's important we reconnect with our friends and colleagues across the community. The idea of visiting every school felt a positive step towards this recovery.

○ How can our staff get involved?

○ How can our pupils get involved?

There are many ways your pupils could get involved, here are some examples, please feel free to use your own too. Encourage active travel, with pupils stopping for a quick selfie outside another school they pass. Perhaps after completing The Daily Mile or Mayor's Golden Kilometre your pupils could pose for a group selfie by their school sign. Another example could be to take a group selfie after attending another school to use their facilities or after a school fixture.

○ Do we need to obtain parental consent before sending BPSS any photographs?

Yes, absolutely. We will be using all photographs we receive on our social media platforms and to form a collage at the end of the challenge. If any pupils are unable to be photographed, you could use an emoji to cover their face 😊.

○ When do we send our selfies and who to?

You can send us your selfies whenever you like, by tagging us on social media, uploading onto Strava or emailing your SGO. We will keep a checklist of which schools have been visited throughout the challenge. You may want to target one which hasn't been ticked off yet. Don't worry if you to send a selfie of a school already visited, there is no limit to the number of times a school can appear.
