#### **FA 'Discover my Talent':**

Now we need your help to shout about girls who you think are talented players and are potential future Lionesses!

Referring players is easy to do. We have an online national referral portal – 'Discover My Talent' – and we would encourage you to refer any girls from any playing environment who you think is a talented player. The window is open until **15 March 2023** and we are currently prioritising players born between 2006 and 2010 (school years 7 to 11).

Players who are referred may either be invited to attend a regional event, be seen within their own playing environment or be invited to a local partner event. All players are considered using our 'Future Lioness Characteristics' to aid with providing a reference as to the type of traits we hope to see – please note that this is not a checklist and we do not expect a player to have every single characteristic but we are keen to know what you think their key attribute is!

#### **ULEZ ZONE**

Many not-for-profit organisations that operate minibuses used for community transport can register for a temporary 100% discount of the ULEZ charge until 26 October 2025.

Once you have registered your vehicle and your eligibility has been confirmed, you will not be charged the ULEZ charge until after the end date of the grace period on 26 October 2025. After this date, all minibuses will need to meet the ULEZ emissions standard or pay the daily ULEZ charge.
