Leadership Training

Bronze Ambassadors Training

Every year we invite primary schools from across Barnet to our bronze ambassador leadership training.

This year we had 14 primary schools attend the training session at Hendon Leisure Centre. Schools choose role models from year 4 and 5 who will take on the sports leadership role to attend the BPSS training session. Within the session students learn how to run personal challenges and a variety of playground games, the importance of safety and understanding what makes a good leader and take part in teamwork exercises.

The aim of the bronze ambassador training is that the leaders will take their new skills back to their school to have a positive impact on physical activity amongst their peers.

The training consisted of a series of workshops led by professionals, and a series of inspiring talks from Paralympians and Olympic athletes. Here's what the leaders had to say

"I thought the Panthalon was really interesting. We did many activities such as bean bag throwing, basketball and bowling, where we explained to the children what to do and cheered them on. I think I enjoyed giving out the medals and certificates most because the looks on their faces were so excited. It was nice to see children with disabilities come out of their comfort zone and work with their classmates to win as many points as they could. I would like to do something like this again to show people that disabilities doesn't make anybody different. I really enjoyed it!"

"I found the day fun as we got to teach different groups of kids our allocated activity and watched to see who got the best score. I enjoyed watching each group play the activity the most as we could watch and see the different ways each child used to try and get the most points and we got to see what techniques worked the best. I learnt many different leadership skills and how to encourage younger SEN children to continue on with the activity even if they don't do so well the first time. I would like to do the whole experience again just maybe with teaching a different activity so I can see how the children approach that activity to how they approached the one I was teaching today."

"I thoroughly enjoyed and thought it was an amazing experience. In my opinion the best part of it was managing and given the opportunity to communicate with the younger years as well as the interactive aspect of it. I learnt a myriad of things such as learning to build confidence in attempts to lead the dedicated group we were assigned with at the time. Overall i would very much enjoy to do this all again I simply cannot pinpoint an exact moment of today that did not excite me in many ways. Thank you for the opportunity."
